

# Early Childhood Program Pricing Schedule and Policies '24-'25

### **Pricing Schedule**

Families may select the attendance option that best fits their needs for the school year. One non-refundable deposit is due upon acceptance. The remaining tuition balance may be paid in full, or divided into nine payments.

If payments are chosen, you will be invoiced on the 15th of each month with the payment due on the 20th. Payments will begin August 20 and end on April 20 to cover the school year attendance.

## **Policies**

#### **Payment**

- Payment Option Invoices will be sent monthly by email August 15 April 15.
- Payments are due on the 20th and are considered late on the 27th (July-April)
- Payments are made through our online payment system.
- A \$30 fee will be charged for late payments.
- A \$50 fee will be charged for bounced payments.
- If a family is late on a payment more than 3 times, the school reserves the right to charge them an additional payment in advance to continue enrollment.
- Families with siblings at SAPMS will receive a discount of 10% off the second student.
- Students with an outstanding balance will not be allowed to attend Early Childhood and may risk losing enrollment to a child on the waitlist.

## Pick-up

To maintain safety standards and staffing requirements, please be present to pick up your child during the designated pick up time. Sometimes emergencies happen and a late pick up is unavoidable. If prior arrangements are not made, a \$30 fee will be assessed plus \$2/minute for each minute you are late.

In the event that it becomes necessary or proper for SAPMS to bring any action for the collection of tuition or other fees, etc., or to consult or place your account with an attorney concerning the payment of money owed, the parent agrees in each and any such case to pay SAPMS's fees for collection, including, but not limited to, reasonable attorney's fees (whether incurred out of court in collection, in court, or appeal, etc.), court costs, interest, and any fees charged by third parties.
