

Extended Day/Aftercare Program Pricing & Policies 2024-2025

The Extended Day Program (3:00pm-5:30pm, 2:00pm start on Wednesday early release days) is a service available to families who register and prepay. Children enrolled are provided with daily activities and outdoor time. It is staffed according to pre-enrollment/space availability.

REGISTRATION

<u>All families enrolling in or using this program are required to pay a registration fee of \$50</u>, in addition to payment for the first month. This is a once per year fee and helps to provide materials necessary for activities within the Extended Day Program. Only one change is permitted, e.g., number of days or disenrollment, per academic year.

POLICIES

Extended Day/Aftercare will be offered on all school days unless outlined on the school's academic calendar. Fees are based on our entire academic year so there will not be reduced costs for months with fewer days. Prepayment is required by the 20th of the month prior to attendance by check or online payment.

Cash will NOT be accepted. Checks will not be accepted by aftercare staff.

- A \$30 fee will be charged for late payments.
- A \$50 fee will be charged for bounced payments.
- Late pick-ups (after 5:30pm) from Extended Day/Aftercare will incur a fee of \$30 plus an additional \$2/min.
- Families with an outstanding balance will not be allowed to attend Extended Day/Aftercare.

PICK-UP PROCEDURE

You will pick up your child each afternoon from the Ballard Street gate. Please ring the bell and use the walkie to alert our staff that you are here to pick up your child. Only adults specified on your enrollment forms will be permitted to pick-up your child; please be sure that they bring a picture ID.

EXPECTATIONS

Participation in the Extended Day/Aftercare Program is a privilege requiring responsibility. Please see our Community Handbook for expectations and redirection procedures that will be used. Students who receive four (4) behavior-related incident reports while in Extended Day/Aftercare, will be disenrolled from the program.
